We work with children and young people affected by sexual abuse, including sexual exploitation who have a current case Social Worker and as part of their assessment it is identified that our intervention would support them to progress in other areas of their lives.

We provide support to children and young people, parents of children affected, foster carers and professionals who may be working with the child or young person.

Our assessments will ensure that we provide the most relevant intervention for children and young people in partnership with all the professionals working in a holistic way.

How to refer

We would like to encourage you to refer to the service if you are working with children who meet the criteria for support.

To ensure a speedy referral acceptance, please ensure that you have prior to a request for service -

- A signed consent form
- A copy of your care plan
- Access to resource panel approval

Please ring or email the office and tell us you would like to make a referral and that you have approval from the Access to Resources Panel, we will then send you an email link so you can send confidential information securely through our Proofpoint secure email system.
